John,

In follow-up to my phone message, we are providing a courtesy notification of an event that occurred at the Lost Creek Project site regarding a small release of yellowcake within the on-site shipping trailer. The event occurred at approximately 10:45 am MST during drum loading operations. The forklift operator, attempting to place another drum onto the trailer, inadvertently impacted another drum with the forklift drum apparatus causing a breach in the side of the drum. A small amount of yellowcake was released onto the deck of the trailer. The breach was quickly sealed to secure from further release. Total release quantity was estimated at less than 0.5 lbs.

Cleanup operations are currently underway as authorized by RWP. Alex has notified the DOT National Response Center in accordance with 49 CFR 171.15(b)(2). We are reviewing additional regulation (10 CFR 20.2202 and 20.2203) for notification requirements to NRC Operations Center. The trailer carrier (RSB Logistics) was also notified. If you have any advice on additional notifications please contact us.
