



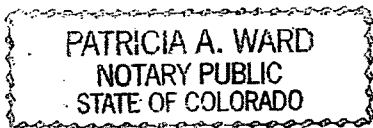

I, James J Graham, being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:

- (1) I am President and Chief Executive Officer of ConverDyn and have been delegated the function of reviewing the information described in paragraph (2) which is sought to be withheld, and have been authorized to apply for its withholding.
- (2) The information sought to be withheld is contained on page 4 of ConverDyn's *Application for NRC Export/Import License, Amendment, or Renewal*.
- (3) In making this application for withholding the proprietary information of which it is the owner, ConverDyn relies upon the exemption from disclosure set forth in the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 USC Sec. 552(b)(4), and the Trade Secrets Act, 18 USC Sec. 1905, and NRC regulations 10 CFR 9.17(a)(4), and 2.790 (a)(4) for "trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential" (Exemption 4). The material for which exemption from disclosure is here sought is all "confidential commercial information," and some portions also qualify under narrower definition of "trade secret," within the meanings assigned to those terms for purposes of FOIA Exemption 4 in, respectively, Critical Mass Energy Project v. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, 975 F2d 871 (DC Cir. 1992).
- (4) Some examples of categories of information which fit into the definition of proprietary information are:
 - a. Information that discloses a process, method, or apparatus, including supporting data and analyses, where prevention of its use by ConverDyn's competitors without license from ConverDyn constitutes a competitive economic advantage over companies;

- d. Information which reveals aspects of past, present, or future ConverDyn customer-funded development plans and programs, of potential commercial value to ConverDyn;
- e. Information which discloses patentable subject matter for which it may be desirable to obtain patent protection.

The information sought to be withheld is considered to be proprietary for the reasons set forth in both paragraphs (4)a. and (4)c. above.

- (5) The information sought to be withheld is being submitted to NRC in confidence. The information is of a sort customarily held in confidence by ConverDyn, and is in fact so held. Its initial designation as proprietary information, and the subsequent steps taken to prevent its unauthorized disclosure, are as set forth in (6) and (7) following. The information sought to be withheld has, to the best of my knowledge and belief, consistently been held in confidence by ConverDyn, no public disclosure has been made, and it is not available in public sources. All disclosures to third parties including any required transmittals to NRC, have been made, or must be made, pursuant to regulatory provisions or proprietary agreements which provide for maintenance of the information in confidence.
- (6) Initial approval of proprietary treatment of a document is made by the President and CEO, the person most likely to be acquainted with the value and sensitivity of the information in relation to industry knowledge. Access to such documents within ConverDyn is limited on a "need to know" basis.
- (7) The procedure for approval of external release of such a document typically requires review by the President and CEO, by the manager of the cognizant marketing function (or his delegate), and by the Legal Operation for content, competitive effect, and determination of the accuracy of the proprietary designation. 

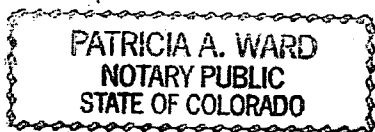


