Re: Reply to Notice of Violation

To Whom It May Concern,

The NRC issued a Notice of Violation in a letter dated November 30, 2017 for "a failure to ensure radioactive waste containers are covered." This letter is in response to the Notice of Violation.

1. The reason for the violation.

The container of waste had been placed in the pond area several years before by staff who were apparently unaware of the need to cover and label the material. The current RSO was unaware of the container or would have ensured it was covered and labeled.

2. The corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved.

The material was properly covered and labeled by site staff on October 19, 2017. All site staff have been made aware of the violation and the requirement to keep all waste material covered and labeled. The requirement has been included into the annual radiation safety training. The remainder of the pond and bone yard area was inspected by the Corporate RSO to ensure all other containers of waste were covered. In addition, the Corporate RSO has asked site personnel to look around and identify any other legacy material that may have been stored inappropriately. Several additional containers have been identified that require labels and or temporary storage in a restricted area.

3. The corrective steps that will be taken.

All necessary steps to prevent a similar reoccurrence have been taken. Any legacy material identified will be labeled, covered, and temporarily placed in restricted areas for waste processing.

4. The date when full compliance will be achieved.

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Full compliance was achieved on October 19, 2017. As legacy material is identified it will be labeled, covered, and temporarily placed in restricted areas to meet full compliance.
