RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL LICENSE

Pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Division 1, Title 17, Chapter 5, Subchapter 4, Group 2, Licensing of Radioactive Material, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, use, possess, transfer, or dispose of radioactive material listed below; and to use such radioactive material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below. This license is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the California Department of Public Health now or hereafter in effect and to any standard or specific condition specified in this license.

LICENSE CONDITIONS

10. Radioactive material shall be used only at the following approved location:

(a) 16926 S. Keegan Avenue, Suite A, Carson, CA.

11. This license is subject to an annual fee for sources of radioactive material authorized to be possessed at any one time as specified in Items 6, 7, 8 and 9 of this license. The annual fee for this license is required by and computed in accordance with Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Sections 30230-30232 and is also subject to an annual cost-of-living adjustment pursuant to Section 100425 of the California Health and Safety Code.

12. Radioactive material shall be used by, or under the supervision of the following individuals:

13. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and store radioactive material described in Items 6, 7, 8 and 9 of this license in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents listed below. The Department's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.

(a) The new application, dated August 11, 2016, with attachments, modified by the letter dated March 1, 2017, with attachments, and revised Radiation Safety Program, dated March 20, 2017, all signed by Simon Siu, Radiation Safety Officer, and supplemented by the electronic mail, dated September 27, 2017, with attachments, sent by Simon Siu, regarding his commitment to visit the site quarterly, the Alternate Radiation Safety Officer revised "Delegation of Authority" form and a revised RH 2050 application request, both dated September 27, 2017, and signed by Simon Siu.

14. (a) The Radiation Safety Officer in this program shall be Simon Siu.

(b) The Alternate Radiation Safety Officer in this program shall be Kyle Pyo.

At least 30 days prior to vacating any address of use listed in Condition 10 of this license, the licensee shall provide written notification of intent to vacate to the California Department of Public Health, in accordance with Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Section 30256 (b). Control of all licensed areas must be maintained until such areas are released by the Department for unrestricted use or the license is terminated, in accordance with Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Section 30256 (j).
17. A copy of this license and a copy of all records and documents pertaining to this license shall be maintained available for inspection at 16926 S. Keegan Avenue, Suite A, Carson, CA.
