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In follow up to my phone message, this is a notice that the water level in the sump for the North Storage Pond had exceeded the 6 inch action level over the weekend. A sample for conductivity was taken from the sump and the results were greater than 50% of the latest pond conductivity value. We were unable to collect a current sample from the Pond since the surface is frozen. Therefore, we request permission to maintain the current status of the Pond which would mean not adding any water to the Pond but also not removing any water to prevent the possibility of creating an ice bridge that could collapse and cause damage to the liner until we can drain it safely.

We will attempt to collect a sample from the Pond somehow for the additional analysis and will submit a sump sample for the additional analysis as well.
