SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Dr. Espar:

In NRC Form 314 "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" dated November 15, 2017, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC Material License No. 13-32652-01 is hereby terminated.
