Kevin;

It was brought to my attention during an NEI conference call, that the DFP review can be completed more efficiently if the following items are specifically called out in the cover letter transmitting the DFP for review. I have added a short comment in red font regarding each of these items.

Spills—no spills that will impact decommissioning costs occurred since the last update.

Increasing waste disposal costs—the estimated cost increases listed in this update of the DFP are primarily due to increased disposal and labor costs.

Facility Modifications—no facility modifications were made since the last update that will impact decommissioning costs.

Changes in authorized possession limits—there are no changes in the authorized possession limits since the last update.

Actual remediation costs that exceed previous cost estimates—no actual remediation costs have occurred since the last update.

Onsite disposal—onsite disposal has never been a practice at this site.

Use of a settling pond—no use of settling ponds has occurred since the last update.

If it will lead to a more efficient review, please docket this e-mail or respond to this email and let me know that you would prefer that I resubmit the cover letter and I will revise it to specifically include the information listed above in a revised cover letter.
