Dear Ms. Axtman:

In letters May 24, 2017 (ML17151A367) and October 13, 2017 (ML17311A141), you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and indicated that you wish to terminate NRC Material License No. 48-09944-01.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee authorized facilities and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC Material License No. 48-09944-01 is hereby terminated.
