I have attended numerous meetings held regarding the decommissioning of the plant. I am baffled why our government would settle on using sub-par storage canisters for temporary storage. The stakes are too high to settle for anything less than state of the art storage. I am gravely concerned that the thinner canisters would not hold up should we experience an earthquake higher than 7.0.
