Dear Mr. Cash:

By letter dated February 27, 2017 (U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML17069A296), Lost Creek ISR, LLC (Lost Creek) submitted to the NRC a request to amend its Materials License SUA-1598 (license). By letters dated July 27, 2017 (ML17199F572), August 28, 2017 (ML17227A311), and October 30, 2017 (17298B724), the NRC staff provided Lost Creek with the request for additional information. By letters dated September 25, 2017 (ML17275A669), December 5, 2017 (ML17353A211) and January 5, 2018 (ML18017A809), Lost Creek submitted responses to the NRC staff's request for additional information.

The NRC staff has completed its administrative review and finds the responses acceptable to complete the detailed technical and environmental review. As you are aware, the NRC is a cooperating agency with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) for development and adoption of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) required under the National Environmental Policy Act and consultations required under the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) for this undertaking. The BLM has been preparing the EIS and NHPA consultation prior to NRC's acceptance of this amendment application, and it is the desire of both agencies to maintain a schedule to complete this project in a timely manner. The NRC staff has been expediting portions of its technical and environmental reviews to try to accommodate the BLM's information needs and schedule for the EIS.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Section 2.390, "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of ADAMS.
