Hi Neil,

Thank you for the question. Just want to make sure we're on the same page first before I get to your question: The RIS is not a requirement or a rule and the staff does not have an expectation that the RIS needs to be complied with. As the RIS is guidance, there isn't an "effective date" per se, like there would be with a rule. With the RIS, the day its issued is the day its available for use as guidance going forward. This would presumably include training development as well if addresses for whom the RIS is targeted opt to utilize its content going forward. So beyond the normal process by which we announce new guidance is available for use, there wouldn't be an "effective date" nor an expectation for compliance once the RIS is issued.

Let me know if this answers your question.

Dave/Wendell,

When RIS 2017-XX is issued and communicated to industry (via letter to licensees I assume), do you plan to specify an effective date for its use? For example, if the RIS was approved on January 1st, 2018, would the NRC specify a particular date, say March 31st, 2018, where industry would be expected to begin complying with the new guidance?

We are beginning to draft our training plan to educate our fleet on use of the new RIS. If there will be a specific date when the new guidance will be expected be complied with, we will tailor our training schedule such that our folks are trained prior to that date.
