Mr. Tebo,

On January 30, 2018, the NRC issued a Notice of Violation to Team Industrial Services, Inc., describing one violation related to NRC security requirements (public cover letter available via the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System accession number ML18032A760) and requiring a reply by Team Industrial within 30 days of the date of the letter. The reply would have been due on March 1, 2018.

Per our telephone conversation yesterday, February 28, 2018, you requested a one-week extension of this due date for Team Industrial's reply to the Notice of Violation due to matters of a personal nature that you were facing. After consultation with Region IV DNMS management, the NRC has agreed to your request for an extension. The new due date for the reply is Friday, March 9, 2018.
