Dear Chairman Svinicki:

I am appointing Ms. Shannon Miller as the new State Liaison Officer to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for the State of Alaska. Ms. Miller is the Department of Environmental Conservation's Interagency Coordination Unit Manager and is in a position within State of Alaska that affords her access to my office and other State agencies in order to convey important and time-sensitive information provided by the NRC. Ms. Miller is also in a position within the State of Alaska to be able to keep your agency informed of important regulatory, legislative, and public interest issues as they occur within the state.

As the Governor-appointed State Liaison Officer, Ms. Miller will also function as my State employee representative, as provided for in Part 73.59(e) of your regulations, for receipt of Safeguards Information (SGI) and Safeguards Information-Modified Handling (SGI-M) that may be transmitted by the NRC. Ms. Miller has been informed of the protection requirements for SGI and SGI-M and will establish the controls necessary to maintain compliance with Parts 73.21 through 73.23 of your regulations.
