I realize the notice to NRC needs to come from Edlow, however, would you check with Jane for me and ask if the detail below would be sufficient if it comes from Marilena for Jane to develop the memo to file? Dear Mrs. Conde:

Due to changing circumstances and a recently locked in schedule associated with the low enriched uranium to be exported under XSNM3763/03, the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), NNSA Production Office, requests Edlow notify the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of compelling circumstances at the Y-12 National Security Complex that now require the amended export license XSNM3763/03 be issued the week of March 18, 2018.

In order for NRC to issue XSNM3763 Amendment 3 the week of March 18, NRC will have to waive the 30 day public notice period, which would have been satisfied on March 26, 2018. It should be noted this amendment 3 is merely an administrative change to document a company name change.

The compelling circumstance is the result of a very near term fixed ship date of first week of April for which transport conveyance is already ordered, and the need for the Y-12 National Security Complex to package, and obtain quality assurance (QA) approvals for loaded shipping containers to be subsequently transfer to Y-12 staging facilities. in order to obtain QA approvals to move material to the staging facility for customer pickup, the license is needed the week of March 18. Other material and customers will be using this transport and it is imperative that Y-12 execute the packaging and shipping approval work next week.
