Lucie County will be discharged into the Atlantic Ocean today, an FPL spokesman said Friday. The water has been filtered to the point that when it is released into a cooling canal on its way to the ocean, the spokesman said, a person could drink the canal water without any radiological effects. The water is to be funneled from the canal into a pipe for discharge into the ocean 1,500 feet offshore. The 3,000-gallons of reactor cooling water overflowed a storage tank April 6 when the unit was shut down briefly following a minor fire the previous week. The water went into a 3.5-million gallon pond at the FPL plant.
