

There has been constant controversy on this subject reported in the News Tribune, our local newspaper. There is some obstacle prolonging construction, and I would be very much interested in knowing what it is.

My personal feelings on this, are that it will provide much needed employment for many persons who are now out of work. As for the environmental aspect, I do not believe that radiation will be a problem due to the numerous testing procedures that are mandatory for a project of this nature.
