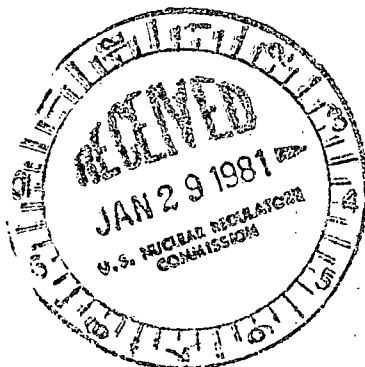
VEPCO IN-HOUSE CORE RELOAD LICENSING

In response to the request in my letter to you dated October 17, 1980, Serial No. 856, Vepco and NRC Staff representatives held an initial planning meeting on December 3, 1980 to discuss Vepco's proposed 1981 in-house licensing activities. We appreciated having the opportunity to meet the appropriate members of the NRC Staff, and we feel that the meeting was most beneficial for all concerned. As discussed during the meeting, Vepco representatives will meet with appropriate members of the Core Performance Branch at 10:00 a.m. on January 28, 1981 to discuss our topical report on physics analysis methodology for reload safety evaluations. In addition, we would be interested in addressing any questions resulting from the review of our previously submitted topical reports on physics or core thermal hydraulics analysis methods. Vepco representatives will also be meeting with members of the Reactor Systems Branch at 10:00 a.m. on February 3, 1981 to discuss our system transient analysis topical report.
