

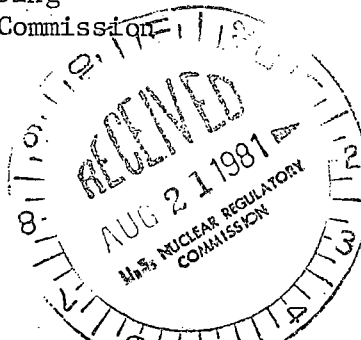

APPLICATION FOR WITHHOLDING PROPRIETARY  
INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

In our letters dated May 15, 1980 (Serial No. 400) and March 6, 1981 (Serial No. 109), we proposed changes to the Technical Specifications for Surry Units No. 1 and No. 2 and North Anna Units No. 1 and No. 2 to permit increases in the enrichment limit for new fuel.

In our letter dated July 24, 1981 (Serial No. 432), we provided as an attachment, clarification of responses to a verbal request from a member of your staff. As indicated in that letter (Serial No. 432), the responses in the attachment contained information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation. This letter is to formally comply with the requirements of 10CFR2.790 to provide proprietary and non-proprietary versions together with an affidavit specifically identifying the proprietary information.

This application for withholding proprietary information provides four (4) copies each of the proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the attachment to letter Serial No. 432. Also enclosed are one (1) Application for Withholding (CAW-81-44) and one (1) Affidavit signed by Westinghouse, the owner of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

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Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that the information which is proprietary to Westinghouse be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10CFR Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations. Correspondence with respect to the proprietary aspects of the application for withholding or supporting Westinghouse affidavits should reference CAW-81-44, and should be addressed to R.A.
