

SURRY POWER STATION UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2
SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 82-05

In our response to Generic Letter 82-05 for the Surry Power Station dated May 17, 1982 (Serial No. 227) Vepco provided a schedule for the completion of the Reactor Coolant Sampling System which is part of Item II.B.3 of NUREG-0737. In our response, we stated that the system was installed and undergoing final startup testing and that the system would be operational by July 1, 1982. The installation status, as stated, is correct, however, the final startup testing has identified several minor system problems. Specifically, the problems identified involve the failure of a vent tank compressor and several internal wiring problems. The failed compressor is being reworked and the system vendor is on-site working on the identified wiring problems.

The existence of these problems will delay the system operational date beyond our July 1, 1982 commitment. As noted, the problems are minor and we do not anticipate a significant delay. We request, however, that our commitment date be changed to September 1, 1982 for the Reactor Coolant Sampling System. We feel that the September date will provide sufficient time to resolve existing and potential new problems.
