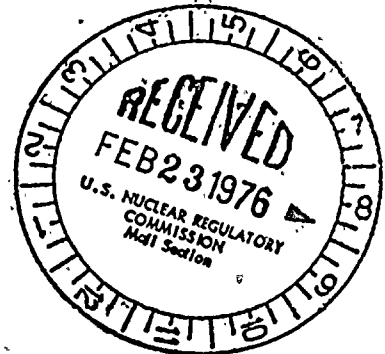

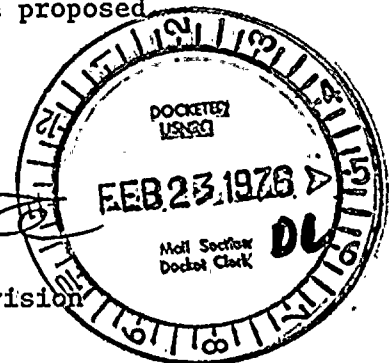
The proposed action does not conflict with existing or authorized plans of the Corps of Engineers. We have no comments concerning the impacts of the proposed plan.
