Please let me hear from you or Mr. Grainey at your earliest convenience.

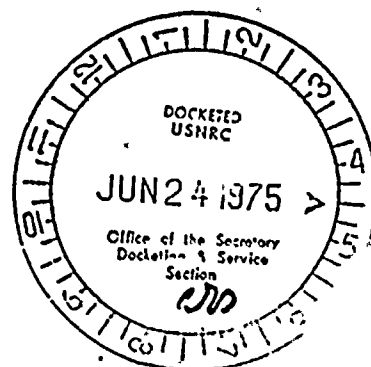
There are also a number of documents we would like to have. A list is attached.

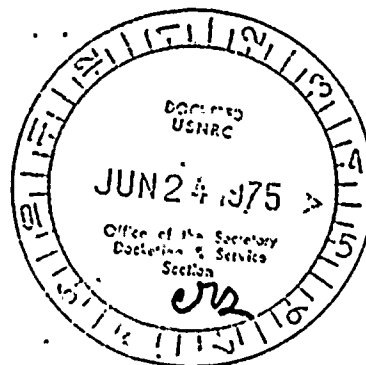
