We find it unconscionable and are appalled that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is considering it to be in the nations best interest for New Mexico to host a "temporary" holding facility for high level nuclear waste from extra-state power reactors. 99% of the reactors in this nation are east of the Mississippi. The waste should stay in the states that use nuclear power. We have received no benefit from these reactors, but are expected to meekly store dangerous waste based on the statements of a greedy corporation.

Moving radioactive waste from one temporary storage facility to another is a ridiculous waste of tax payer money. It is dangerous and seems to be just a way for Holtec to make money at the expense of our state, our lands, national safety and the lives of the local people, as well as the people all along the transportation routes.

When there is an accident, how far will the radioactive spill travel?
