Mr. Wagner,

Good afternoon. This refers to your request for license termination received on May 22, 2018 ([ML18159A400](#)). In order to complete the review of the application, please reply to each of the following items within **10 days** of this correspondence. Your responses must be in the form of a signed and dated from yourself as the licensee Certifying Officer for WVA Manufacturing, LLC. Preferably the letter will be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email to me. Alternatively, it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269 or it may be sent by regular paper delivery (such as US mail) to the Region I address on the NRC from 313.

1. Do you have leak tests for the items that were in storage, i.e., numbers 15 through 37 on the attached spreadsheet? If not, were surveys done of the storage area done showing that no sources stored had leaked?
2. Do you have documentation showing that each item on the list, as identified by its serial numbers, was in the disposal manifest attached in your request (also attached for your convenience)? You need to show that all 37 of your sealed sources were in the disposal manifest.
3. Can you provide better legible copies of the manifests you provided in your request, i.e., scan at 600 DPI and email back?
4. Can you provide the total activity in each manifest? It was impossible to read.

Please contact me when you receive this request at 410-507-9927, so we can discuss.
