On behalf of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes, thank you for the notification of the proposed agreement with the State of Wyoming. At this time, we disagree with this arrangement due to the State of Wyoming's inability to comply with Section 106 and NEPA regulations. Without these regulations in place, we would not be notified of Adverse Effects to Traditional Cultural Properties or to consult before an Adverse Effect. As such, If the State of Wyoming assumes regulatory authority over disposal of byproduct materials, we strongly recommend continued consultation with tribes under Section 106 and NEPA.
