Any environmental, health and safety documents signed or executed by Ana G. Marino shall have the same force and effect, and shall bind Union Carbide Corporation, as if done by me. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, I am an authorized signatory for the Company as defined in 40 CFR 98.4, 40 CFR 122.22, 40 CFR 144.32, and 40 CFR 270.11, and a Responsible Official as defined in 40 CFR 70.2.

I explicitly stipulate that the individual named above is restricted to re-delegating any authority granted by this Delegation unless that delegation is executed in writing and the re-delegation is approved by the Law Department as meeting requirements of the environmental regulations referenced in the paragraph above.

This Delegation shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified by me or my successor, in writing. This Delegation supersedes and replaces any prior delegations.

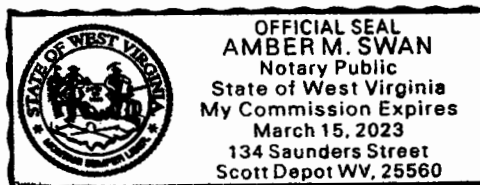


