IES Engineers is working with LSRP Mr. D.J. Varner of AES to complete a NJ ISRA in support of a Preliminary Assessment Report. We are seeking information regarding the closure of NRC License 29-30471-01 issued to EpiGenesis Pharmaceuticals Inc., PO Box 7007, Princeton, NJ 08543 for radioisotope use at its 2005 Eastpark Boulevard in Cranbury, New Jersey which operated 1998-2002. The license was issued on September 30, 1998 (see attached PDF copy).

Specifically, we are looking for any license closure documentation that shows that NCR released the site for unrestricted use. This includes, but is not limited to, correspondence or documentation from the NRC stating that the license has been closed and that there is no remaining contamination on site, documentation or correspondence from the NRC that the site is free for unrestricted use, a signed Certificate of Disposition of Materials, a Final Status Survey Report (FSSR), etc.
