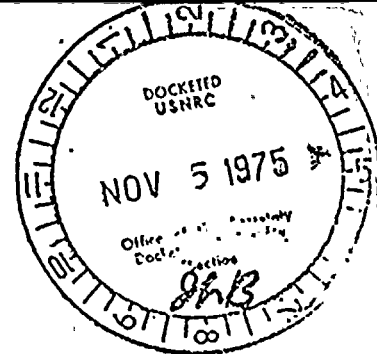

Dear Mr. Rusche:

This is to acknowledge Mr. Walter Butler's letter of September 18, 1975, delineating the staff's position with regard to scheduling resumption of the public hearing for the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant. Carolina Power & Light Company hereby provides the NRC staff with the requested information necessary to schedule its review and to project a date for resumption of the public hearing.

The information to confirm the ability of the ECCS for the Harris units to meet the Final Acceptance Criteria will be submitted in spring, 1976. The Fuel Handling Building will be redesigned to accommodate the tornado pressure drop rate contained in Regulatory Guide 1.76 and the tornado missiles specified in Standard Review Plan 3.5.1.4.

As agreed to with members of the staff, the need for power and financial information will be provided in a timely manner to permit the staff ample time to review the submitted information before the resumption of the public hearing. The dates for these submittals will be determined after the resumption of the public hearing has been formally scheduled.

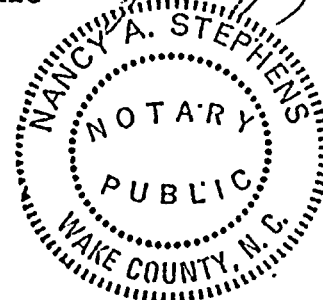

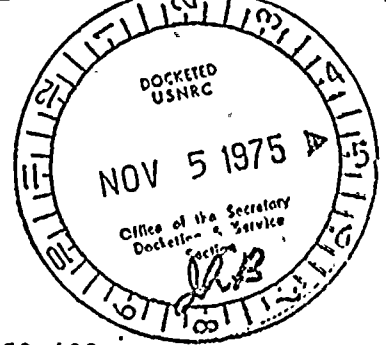
