This is in reference to the application dated July 10, 2018 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-02406-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. To support your request to relocate your main nuclear medicine department:
  - a. Please describe the areas adjacent to, above, and below the nuclear medicine department.
  - b. Please confirm that, in addition to the policies and procedures, the equipment described in your renewal application dated November 23, 2018, will continue to be used at the new facility. If new hot lab equipment will be used, please provide a description of the new equipment (i.e., survey meters, well counter, etc.), including manufacturer, model number, and probe information.
2. Please confirm that the sources you are requesting to add will be used and possessed in accordance with 10 CFR 35.65 or 10 CFR 35.500. If the sources will be possessed in accordance with 35.500, please indicate if these sources are in addition to or replacing the sources currently listed on your license. If replacing the sources currently listed, please submit documentation demonstrating final disposition of the sources and the most recent leak test.

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information. You may respond to my attention in writing by letter, email (if letter is signed by senior management and scanned into a pdf format), or fax (610-337-5269), referencing mail control number 609431. Please respond within 30 days of the date of this email. If you have any questions regarding this deficiency letter, please call me at (610) 337-5143.
