SUMMARY

As requested by Ken Lambert, I called the licensee's RSO to obtain information regarding whether or not the apparent violation of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 20.1802, 10 CFR 30.34(i), and NRC License Number 21-18598-02, Amendment 12, License Condition 19.A., involving the licensee's apparent failure to control a portable gauge (gauge) that was in a controlled area and not in storage on August 23, 2017, resulting in damage to the gauge should be a Severity Level IV violation in accordance with Enforcement Guidance Memorandum 18-002 (EGM).

The RSO stated that: (1) the licensee failed to maintain control and constant surveillance of the portable gauge during operational conditions; (2) the licensee failed to maintain control and constant surveillance of the portable gauge for about 5 minutes in a remote location; (3) the only individual that contacted the gauge was the authorized user; (4) there was no unintended exposure to an individual; and (5) the source was shielded in the gauge and there was no radioactive contamination.

ACTION REQUIRED

The NRC will use the information above to determine if the apparent violation should be a Severity Level IV violation, as per the EGM.
