Subject: Follow up to LES-18-069 Notification to Inspect CAB for Decommissioning and Approval of LAR 18-02


Reference: 1) LES-18-069-NRC License Amendment Request (LAR) 18-02, Removal of the ETUS SPPP and Revision of the UUSA SPPP to Eliminate CAB Operations (dated June 21, 2018)

In Reference 1, Louisiana Energy Services dba URENCO USA (UUSA), declared our intent to cease classified operation in the Centrifuge Assembly Building (CAB). Reference 1 requests review and approval of an amendment to Materials License SNM-2010 to delete License Condition 10.i, Standard Practice Procedure Plan (SPPP) for the Protection of Classified Matter at Enrichment Technologies-United States (ETUS).

In support of this request, the NRC is to visually inspect the CAB for removal of classified matter. This correspondence hereby notifies the NRC that UUSA and ETUS will be ready to support an onsite inspection in October 2018. Specifically, UUSA requests this inspection take place the week of October 15, 2018. UUSA will work with NRC through our Project Manager to set an inspection date.
