To Whom It May Concern:


On June 28, 2017, Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOG) submitted a License Amendment Request (LAR) (Reference 1) to incorporate a new specification into the Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS) Technical Specifications (TS), TS 3.7.20, "Class 1E Electrical Equipment Air Conditioning (A/C) System." Reference 2 was a Supplement to the WCNOG LAR. In Reference 3, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Staff transmitted a Request for Additional Information (RAI). Reference 4 provided RAI responses, which included

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committed actions. The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC Staff that WCNOG has met the Regulatory Commitments listed in Reference 4.

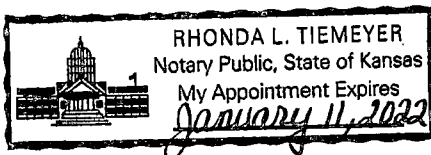
