RE: Application for License for the Export and Import of Deuterium Oxide (D20) -HES3263

Deputy Director,

Halliburton Energy Services, Inc. is applying for a license to export: Deuterium Oxide (D20) to Iraq. The end-use of the Deuterium Oxide (D20) requested in this license for coring operations. This is a mud tracing technique to enable the determination of core contamination. The amount of coring fluid contamination contained in the formation water of a core sample can be determined using a deuterium oxide (heavy water) tracer. Deuterium oxide is added to the mud (fluid) system, prior to coring. During the coring process, depending on the oil & gas company requirement, the D20 concentration will be determined. It is estimated, we will require 2.94 KG of D20 per 100 BBL, and therefore, we are requesting a quantity of 150 KG.

The deuterium Oxide (D20) will be used to provide coring services to Basra Oil Company and Rumaila Technical Services both located in the Basra, Iraq area. Deuterium Oxide is subject to the export-licensing jurisdiction of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The deuterium Oxide (D20) will remain in the custody of Halliburton Worldwide Limited (HWL) at all times, and when not in use, will be stored in a secure facility controlled by HWL.

Halliburton Energy Services, Inc., in consideration of Title 10, Part 110.42 (c) of the Code of Federal Regulations, submits that the NRC-Controlled items proposed for export are not inimical to the common defense and security of the United States and the proposed exports are consistent with the policies and objectives of the United States Government.
