BLUEFIN, LLC purchased the assets (with a few exceptions) of PRSI, Inc. on September 4, 2018. There will be no PRSI representation on the BLUEFIN Board of Directors; however, PRSI's 90% shareholder is being retained on a consulting basis, and its 10% shareholder, Michael McGonigle, is now a BLUEFIN employee. Mr. McGonigle will still have responsibility for operations of our Delaware office (fka PRSI). The other full-time PRSI employees have also accepted employment offers at BLUEFIN and will continue to perform essentially the same jobs as they did at PRSI. Bluefin LLC does not currently have a Radioactive Material License or control over one with the NRC or other agreement state.

There will be no changes in the program. Jim Gould will remain the Radiation Safety Officer. The Troxler 3216 Roof Gauge will continue to be housed in the Newark, Delaware office. 
