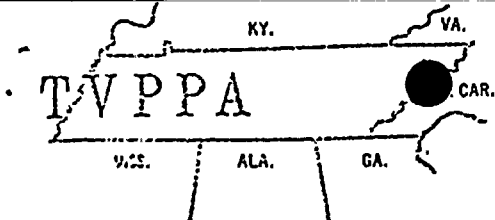



RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Valley Authority on June 21, 1976, filed a motion with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for an order authorizing Control Rod Drive Systems and Full Core Shutdown Margin Tests on Browns Ferry Nuclear Plants Units 1 and 2, and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Valley Authority during the month of June paid \$21,000,000 for purchased power to replace power that would have been generated at Browns Ferry at a much lower figure, and

WHEREAS, if TVA is not authorized to operate Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant during July and August, 1976, the extra cost of purchased power for the three months, June, July and August will be in excess of \$70,000,000, to be paid by the consumers of TVA power,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tennessee Valley Public Power Association strongly urges prompt action on the part of all concerned to restore the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant to full operation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution be sent to the Honorable Gerald Ford, President of the United States; Marcus Rowden, Esq., Chairman of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission; Thomas W. Reilly, Esq., Chairman of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission; all members of the Tennessee Valley delegation in the Congress, and the 157 member systems of the Tennessee Valley Public Power Association.
