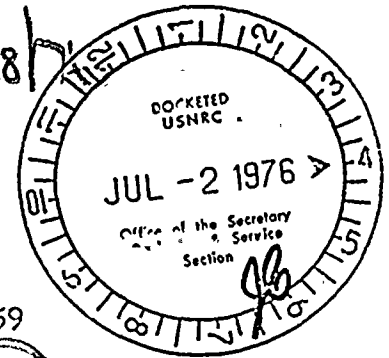

Intervenor's Request to Board To Re-open Discovery to Permit Interrogatories Relative to Supplement No. 1 to the SER

On June 18, 1976, the NRC Staff issued Supplement No. 1 to the Safety Evaluation by the Division of Operating Reactors, Supporting the Operation After the Restoration and Modification of the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, Following the March 22, 1975 fire. Supplement No. 1, including appendices, is about as lengthy as the SER. The Supplement departs in some ways from the SER.

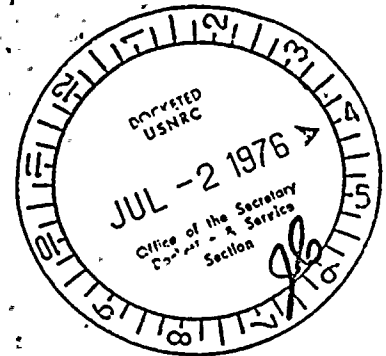
Intervenor requests the Board to re-open discovery to permit Intervenor to propound written interrogatories to Applicant and Staff relative to the Supplement. Intervenor suggests that ten (10) days from the date of a Board Order would be a reasonable time to file his interrogatories, and that ten (10) days from the date of filing would be a reasonable time for Applicant and Staff to respond.
