

(After Prior Increase)


It is agreed that:

The original limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations, the limit(s) of liability stated in the Increase of Limit of Liability Endorsement(s) listed below and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above shall not be cumulative, and each payment made by the companies after the effective date of this endorsement for any loss or expense covered by the policy shall reduce by the amount of such payment the limit of liability originally stated in Item 4 of the declarations, the amended limit(s) of liability stated in the Increase of Limit of Liability Endorsement(s) listed below and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above, regardless of which limit of liability applies with respect to the bodily injury or property damage out of which such loss or expense arises.




