Inspection Program Revisions

- NRC will conduct 1 force-on-force (FOF) exercise

Summary of NRC-conducted FOF Inspection Revisions	
Planning week ('A' Week)	Exercise week ('B' Week)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 'A' week reduced ½ day for single exercise planning• Reduce the number of inspection team members. Revised Team composition: 1 Team Lead and 2 team members.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maintain current team composition: 1 Team Lead and 3 team members• Reduce on-site inspection time by 1 day• The Significance Determination Process will be revised for a single inspection.
Direct Inspection Effort reduced by ~70 hours	Direct Inspection Effort reduced by ~40 hours

IP 71130.05, Protective Strategy and Performance Evaluation Program

Enhanced Inspection of licensee-conducted exercise incorporated into current inspection effort

Expand guidance in Inspection Procedure 71130.05 relative to:

- 1) Scenario planning and development
- 2) Adversary Planning and preparation
- 3) MILES calibration and maintenance

MILES evaluation

- Considering MILES/SAAB capabilities
- Evaluating system capability with respect to:
 - Adversary weapon systems
 - Responder weapon systems
 - Data generation

Considerations for indeterminate exercise outcomes

- Implementing and refining operational control measures to eliminate indeterminate outcomes
 - Expanded evaluations (resurrecting and or resetting players)
 - Considerations associated with total inspection effort
- Assign an exercise outcome for licensee-conducted exercises as additional data point in case an indeterminate outcome occurs
 - In the case of 2 indeterminate outcomes staff will conduct additional FOF and short cycle licensee FOF inspection (reset triennial date)
