



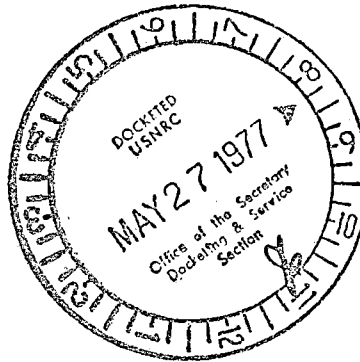


Dear Chairman Rowden:
