I would like to nominate Mr. Steven Lynch as the authorized U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) representative for the working group tasked with developing the new American Nuclear Society (ANS) standard 15.22, "Classification of Structures, Systems and Components for Research Reactors."

Mr. Lynch is a project manager in the NRC's Research and Test Reactors Licensing Branch in the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. He is responsible for coordinating the NRC's licensing reviews for facilities intending to produce molybdenum-99. These licensing reviews involve classifying structures, systems, and components for novel technologies, including new designs for non-power reactors.
