Nordion has received your letter, dated December 6, 2018, consenting to Nordion's request for transfer of control of the two licenses.

The letter stipulates that Nordion notify the NRC within 30 days of the letter whether the transfer was undertaken. In order to provide sufficient time to allow us to compile documents proving the transfer occurred, and to account for any delays which might occur, we are requesting an extension to the 30 day notice period. We request that notice be provided by January 29, 2018. This timing would then also be consistent with the timing outlined in the letter from the Office of International Program consenting to the transfer.
