**ORDER APPROVING INDIRECT TRANSFER OF CONTROL OF OPERATING
LICENSE AND COMBINED LICENSES**

Dear Mr. Nieh and Mr. Brown:

In Reference 1 and Reference 2, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approved the indirect transfer of control of Operating License No. NPF-12 and Combined License Nos. NPF-93 and NPF-94, Docket Nos. 50-395, 52-027, 52-028, and 72-1038 for the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station (VCSNS), Units 1, 2 and 3 and its Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation. Section III of each Order requires that South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (SCE&G) provide notice in writing after receipt of all required regulatory approvals for the proposed indirect transfer action no later than 2 business days prior to the date of the closing of the indirect transfer.


The indirect transfer arises from an "Agreement and Plan of Merger" dated January 2, 2018. The proposed transaction involves a merger between Dominion Energy, Inc. (Dominion Energy) and SCANA Corporation (SCANA), the parent holding company of SCE&G. The merger

transaction will be accomplished through the merger of SCANA with Sedona Corp. (Sedona), a South Carolina corporation and subsidiary of Dominion Energy formed for the sole purpose of merging with SCANA. The acquisition of SCANA by Dominion Energy will be effected by the merger of Sedona with and into SCANA, with SCANA being the surviving corporation. Effective upon such merger, SCANA will be a direct wholly-owned subsidiary of Dominion Energy, and the former shareholders of SCANA will be shareholders of Dominion Energy. SCE&G will remain a direct wholly-owned subsidiary of SCANA.

In accordance with the requirements of Section III of the Orders, Reference 3 provided notification to the Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation and the Director of the Office of New Reactors that all required regulatory approvals of the indirect transfer action had been received, and provided 2 business days' prior notice of the closing. This letter provides notice to NRC that the parties plan to complete the closing effective as of January 1, 2019.
