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Dear Mr. Gupta,

This is in reference to your letter dated December 11, 2018, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-35183-01, Docket No. 03038780. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You have requested a new location to be added to the license, but you have not informed us about the facility other than its address. Section 8.9 of NUREG-1556, Volume 12, Rev. 1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses Program-Specific Guidance About Possession Licenses for Manufacturing and Distribution," section 8.9 states for the applicant to:
  - a. Describe the facilities and equipment to be made available at each location where radioactive material will be possessed or possessed and used (see Appendix F of this NUREG for topics to consider). This information should be from the point of view of performance criteria. For example, state the purpose of any filtration equipment and the associated acceptance criteria to accomplish this purpose (such as the ventilation flow rate trying to be maintained).
  - b. Include a description of the areas assigned for the receipt, shipping, storage, preparation, security, and measurement of radioactive materials. Submit a diagram showing the locations of shielding, the proximity of radiation sources to unrestricted areas, areas containing flammable or hazardous materials, and other items related to radiation safety (see Figure 8-6).
  - c. Diagrams should be drawn to a specified scale or dimensions should be indicated. Sketches or drawing should also include a compass directional arrow to indicate "North".
  - d. For facilities where it is anticipated that more than one laboratory or room may be used, a generic laboratory or room diagram may be submitted.

Please provide this information.

2. The Summer Street location will remain on the license. After the amendment and you move your material, please submit an amendment to remove the Summer Street location. Please submit radiation surveys and other documentation appropriate for release of facilities. Guidance can be found in NUREG-1757, Volume 1, Rev. 2, "Consolidated Decommissioning Guidance Decommissioning Process for Materials Licensees.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter.
