Hello Jane,

Sorry for the delay in getting back to you on this matter, I have finally heard back from our customer

The Group AREVA has been fully reorganized. It was made of several entities :

- The entity in charge of uranium mines and nuclear fuel activities (enrichment, recycling) is now named ORANO*
- The previous entity AREVA NP, who is in charge of the reactor conception and nuclear plants, is now named FRAMATOME (as it was in past), and is now part of the French company EDF (Electricité de France)*
- The entity AREVA TA, who is our customer for the RJH, has become in independent company named TECHNICATOME, which is not part of ORANO nor EDF. The shareholders of TechnicAtome are the French government (50.3%, Naval Group, CEA and EDF).*

So the name to put on the licence instead of AREVA TA is TECHNICATOME, and the site address in Aix-en-Provence is still the same.

Andrea,

I have reviewed your XCOM1305 license and since it does not specify the quantities of beryllium reflector

assemblies or associated minor reactor components, the license does not preclude return for cleaning and reworking and re-export before December 29, 2018. If there is any possibility that the work will not be completed or the items will not be re-exported before that date, you may wish to request that the license be renewed to extend the expiration date (and update the names of intermediate consignees), just to be sure.

I call your attention to 10 CFR §§ 110.51 (Amendment and renewal of licenses), 110.53 (United States address, records, and inspections) and 110.54 (Report requirements).
