ORDER
(Scheduling Second Telephonic Conference Call)

On December 6, 2018, the Board held its first conference call with the parties to this proceeding since the issuance of LBP-18-5 to discuss the NRC Staff's decision to resume implementation of its March 2018 Approach to identify historic, cultural, and religious sites at Powertech's Dewey-Burdock in situ recovery project.¹ During that conference, the NRC Staff suggested that monthly telephone status conference calls with the Board be reinstituted.² The parties have agreed to a second telephone conference to be held on Tuesday, January 29, 2019 beginning at 3:15 pm Eastern Time. The Board anticipates that this conference will last no more than two hours.

The Board will establish a bridge line for this telephone conference, with three lines provided for each party. Listen-only telephone access will also be made available for members of the public. The Board's law clerk will contact the participants by email to provide the telephone number and passcodes for participation and listen-only access. Members of the

During the conference, the Board would like to discuss the Oglala Sioux Tribe's January 11, 2019 response to the NRC Staff's November 21, 2018 letter,³ including the parties' views regarding any need for changes to the protective order in this proceeding.⁴ We will also discuss any progress made by the NRC Staff in its efforts to resolve Contention 1A, in particular, finding a replacement for Dr. Nickens,⁵ involving the Federal, State, and Tribal Liaison Branch in discussions with the Tribe,⁶ developing an agreement on a site survey methodology,⁷ and establishing a schedule for implementing the various aspects of the March 2018 Approach.
