**REPORT OF CHANGES TO THE RANCHO SECO QUALITY ASSURANCE
PROGRAM THAT DO NOT REQUIRE PRIOR NRC APPROVAL**

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(a)(3) and 10 CFR 50.4(b)(7), SMUD is required to submit a copy of changes to the Rancho Seco Quality Manual (RSQM) that do not reduce commitments in the quality assurance program previously accepted by the NRC. Changes to the quality program that do not reduce commitments in the program can be made without prior NRC approval.

During calendar year 2018, no changes were made to the RSQM without NRC approval. The RSQM was changed to Revision 4 upon termination of the 10 CFR 50 license. RSQM, Revision 4, was reviewed and approved by the NRC as documented in letter "TERMINATION OF RANCHO SECO NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION OPERATING LICENSE DPR-54" dated August 31, 2018.

The RSQM continues to implement the requirements of 10 CFR Part 72, Subpart G. The individuals and organizations performing quality assurance functions continue to have sufficient authority, organizational freedom, and independence from cost and schedule issues.

Since the 10 CFR 50 license was terminated effective August 31, 2018 and all future RSQM revisions under 10 CFR 72 require prior NRC approval, SMUD intends to cease submitting this report to the NRC.
