Enclosed is an application from RSB Logistic Inc., dated December 31, 2018, requesting Amendment No. 09 to its existing export license XSOU8798/08. This license presently authorizes the export of up to 12,000,000 kilograms of natural uranium to Canada, in the form of ore concentrate ( $U_3O_8$ ) for conversion into  $UF_6$ ,  $UO_2$ , or  $UO_3$ , and return to the U.S. for future processing.

The purpose of the amendment is to add one "Other U.S. Party(ies) to Export".

Since there are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested, our office is processing this as a minor amendment. We intend to issue the requested license after the 30-day time period allotted for public review has expired, and it is determined that applicable export license criteria are met.
