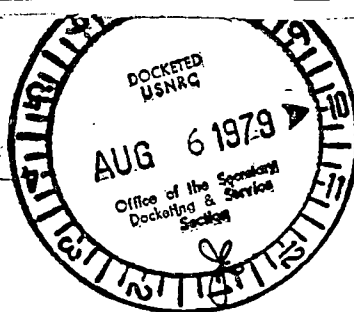

Gentlemen: Re: Salem #2.
It is my understanding when Salem #2 receives an operating license, included in the license will be the allowance to hold 17 yrs. storage on the spent fuel pool.

There is an intervention pending against the re-racking and 17 yrs. storage at Salem #1. It would appear to not be in the best interest of the public to issue a license to Salem #2 until the safety questions are fully addressed with Salem #1.

Five in the L.P.Z. of Salem #1, Salem #2, Cape Creek #1, and Cape Creek #2. The two Salem units alone, if permission is granted could mean 34 yrs of storage of spent fuel.

Now is the time to take time to explore the effects of this action. Please advise.
