I reviewed the RATS ID and the only sections that apply to us is the Part 40 and 71. In reviewing the changes most are compatibility categories NRC. The only part that I saw that was not NRC was 10 CFR Part 71.97 which was compatibility category B. Because 71.97 is outside the scope of our agreement we excluded this in the original rulemaking. That being said it appears there are no needed changes to comply with 2018-2. As we are still new to this what would the State need to submit in order to show we did not need to make any changes? Any help would be appreciated, please feel free to call or email with further instructions on how to demonstrate compliance. Thanks for your patience with us as we are still new to the processes.
