
Dear Chairman Anders:

How can O.I.E. & B. expand their facilities for more storage of spent fuel?

According to the safety evaluations all studies on the impact and effects are evaluated relevant to the original storage design.

The original design was to hold $1\frac{1}{3}$ cores and now we are being told it will hold with new racks 4 cores. The plant could operate 9 yrs without moving spent fuel off the site and still have room to dump one whole core.

I understand the design of the new racks is complete and bids to go out soon.

How will this affect the safety margin?

What effect will this have on the spent fuel pool cooling system?

When was this revised? How reviewed?

Does this make P.T. a storage depot? (or set the wheels in motion for one)

If outside facilities for spent fuel not available (they are not for Salem) and will not be until? Who has the authority to regulate this storage?
