
Dear Ms. Gaskins:

To ensure a smooth transition to a physician RSO to our practice, we will have our consultant physicist, Peter J. Mas, MS, serve as the RSO while we seek to bring Dr. Timothy James Glew into that role.

On behalf of this practice, Mr. Peter J. Mas, MS, will have the authority to intervene and address situations that may represent a risk to the health and safety of our patients &/or of the staff. For his role as the RSO, he is provided key access to the three imaging sites and is able to review the operations at any convenient time. We are aware that he serves as RSO to Stamford Hospital (NRC License 06-06697-02) and to four separately licensed practices. We are able to communicate with Mr. Mas via email, telephone and text message. If an urgent situation were to arise, he will be able to assist and if need be, return to the area if engaged in other work. Lastly, his efforts are expected to require 1 to 1.5 hr per week for our operations.
